## Guidelines for Article Submissions:

- 15-25 pages in length (including endnotes and bibliography), double-spaced, with standard-sized margins, font size, and style;
- Formatted according to Chicago Manual of Style;
- Include an abstract (150-300 words) and 3-5 keywords;
- Page numbers on the top right corner of each page;
- Do not include a title page.
